Access to buildings checklist.

Some key requirements to make your buildings accessible to disabled customers and employees:

- Are parking spaces reserved for people with mobility difficulties and are these reserved areas observed by others?
- Are the kerbs, between the parking areas and the building ramped?
- Is a ramp available for stepped areas - both leading into the building and within the building?
- If there is more than one floor in the building, is a lift provided?
- Are corridors and doorways wide enough for wheelchair users?
- Are floor surfaces even?
- Are all telephone wires and electrical cables well concealed?
- Are toilets accessible for wheelchair users or people who have other mobility impairments?
- Are there agreed and known emergency evacuation procedures in place for disabled people?
