Disability Awareness checklist.

- You must be aware that disabled people are people first
- You must be aware of your own attitudes to disabled people and the importance of understanding their needs
- You must be aware that disabled people have individual needs which are related to the situation and not the impairment
- You must be aware of negative thoughts and language associated with disabled people
- You must be aware of the importance of access and the barriers that may prevent it, i.e. inaccessible buildings, inappropriate communication and people's negative/inappropriate attitudes
- You must be aware of the importance of meeting and listening to disabled people
- You must be aware that disability awareness is one aspect of an equal opportunities and diversity approach
